Part of the PhD basic program of the Research School Political History is the module 'Key concepts in Political History.' In this module, the focus is on power. Two eminent scholars will speak about the way in which they use this concept. Their presentations will be followed by in depth discussion in which PhD candidates reflect on the way they use 'power' in their own research.

PhD candidates have to read literature, prepare for the module and participate actively in the debate.

Supervisors and speakers are:

Susie Protschky (VU Amsterdam) is professor of Global Political History. She is specialised in modern Dutch colonialism, Indonesian history, and the history of photography. She will discuss the way in which she uses the concept of power in her analysis of photographs.

Annelien de Dijn (Utrecht University) is professor of Modern Political History. Her research focuses on the history of political thought in Europe and in the United States from 1700 to the present day. She will discuss the way she uses intellectual history to study power.
