We are pleased to announce that Gert Oostindie, professor emeritus of Colonial and Postcolonial History at Leiden University and former Director of the KITLV/Royal Netherlands Institute of Southeast Asian and Caribbean Studies, will deliver this year's keynote lecture. In his lecture, titled 'Colonialism & Memory Wars', Oostindie will explore the recent resurgence of interest in Dutch colonial history within Dutch society and politics. His primary focus, however, is to reflect on the merits, challenges and pitfalls of the present boom in critical colonial studies.
